

SUBSTANCE ABUSE POLICY

If you or your designee reports to the school to sign-out a student for the remainder of the school day and any staff member believes that you may appear impaired for any reason or detects the odor of alcohol or marijuana, regardless of the legal status of the substance(s), you will NOT be permitted to remove the student from school and you or your designee will have to arrange alternative transportation for the student. - HELP YOUR CHILD FIGURE OUT APPROPRIATE BOUNDARIES FOR WHAT IS SHARED ONLINE.
- THE SCHOOL DISTRICT UTILIZES SECURITY SOFTWARE TO IDENTIFY INAPPROPRIATE CONTENT ON SCHOOL DEVICES.
- MAKE SURE YOUR CHILD'S SCHOOL DEVICE IS CHARGED EACH NIGHT. IF A SCHOOL DEVICE IS LOST OR DAMAGED BEYOND REPAIR THERE IS A \$150 REPLACEMENT FEE FOR THE LAPTOP AND A \$50 REPLACEMENT FEE FOR THE LAPTOP CHARGER.
- CHECK PARENT PORTAL REGULARLY (ALL PARENTS MUST REGISTER FOR PARENT PORTAL). IT IS NOW A REQUIREMENT THAT PARENTS LOG ON AND
 VIEW THEIR CHILD'S GRADES AND ATTENDANCE AT LEAST THREE TIMES PER MARKING PERIOD TO ENSURE YOUR CHILD'S ELIGIBILITY TO PARTICIPATE
 IN ALL YEAR-END GRADE LEVEL ACTIVITIES.
- NOTIFY THE SCHOOL OF ANY CHANGES IN PERSONAL INFORMATION SUCH AS PHONE NUMBERS.
- PARENTS SHOULD STAY INVOLVED IN SCHOOL- ATTEND SCHOOL EVENTS AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE (IT IS NOW A REQUIREMENT FOR PARENTS TO
